



What you need to bring with you:

1. Sleeping Bag and small air mattress if you don't want to sleep on the floor.
2. Pillow
3. Bible
4. Something to write with
5. Towel/Wash Cloths
6. Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant
7. Toothbrush & Toothpaste
8. Other toiletries and personal items
9. Bug Spray and Sunscreen (We will be outside).
10. Snacks for the week
11. Clothes for each day/ change of clothes for after outside activities
12. Bathing suit for swimming (Modesty is key, girls one piece or cover up and guys no speedos)
13. River shoes and close toed shoes for hiking needed.
14. Sturdy Personal Water Bottle (Label it)
15. Any medications students need (make sure these are listed on medical release form and are in labeled bottle.
16. Fold up camping chair for nightly worship service.
17. Fishing pole and supplies if you plan to fish. If you are 16 or older you will need an Arkansas Fishing License. They sell 3 day license which you should get for July 7-9 if purchasing. Student Expectations

1. You will be representing Christ and your church. Your behavior all week should reflect this.
