Do not think because you have other service to do that therefore you should take no interest in this form of holy work. But kindly, according to your opportunities, stand ready to help the little ones and to cheer those whose chief calling is to attend to them. To use all this message comes: "Feed my lambs." To all who have any knowledge of the things of God, the commission is given. See to it that you look after the children that are in Christ Jesus."
